Application Summary Surface must be dry, clean and free from any loose particles. Concrete (not previously coated) should be acid etched, water blasted clean and allowed to dry before applying the sealer.

Application by roller is preferred (medium pile) but it can be brushed with a soft broom or sprayed with suitable equipment. Allow to dry between coats (1-2 hours)
